*"Every man praying or prophesying, having his head covered, dishonors his head" (1 Cor. 11:4)*  
 To be veiled, or to wear a head-covering, was, in the days of Paul, either an act of subjection, or an act of shame. In the eastern world, being bare-headed proclaimed subjection, and being covered declared superiority and dominion. Paul, literally turned this custom on its head. He said, that the man that prays or prophesies with his head covered dishonors his head, namely, Christ. He also asserted that the head of every man is Christ (1 Cor. 11:3). In this, Paul made it clear that acceptance of the roles God has given are to be accepted; that in every manner, including personal dress, we are to avoid that which would dishonor Christ.

Paul wrote that the woman who prays or prophesies with her head uncovered dishonors her head, namely, the man, (1 Cor. 11:3). In this action she throws off the token of her subjection, and states her desire to change roles; to have the role God conferred on man. The order established by the Lord God has placed persons and things is correct and best. To endeavor to change those roles is to destroy order. For one to dishonor the role established by God is to in fact dishonor God.

The man is the image of God, the head and representative of that dominion which God alone has over the world. The man was set, by the Creator, at the head of the lower creation, and in that role he bears His image and derives glory. The woman, is the glory of the man (1 Cor. 11:7). She is the image of God, inasmuch as she is the image of the man, for the woman was made out of the man, (1 Cor. 11:8). The man was first made and given dominion. The woman was made out of the man, with a reflection of his glory, superior to the creatures, but in subjection to her husband, and deriving honor from him.

The woman was made for the man, to be his help-fit. She was made subject to him. According to Paul, in her subjection to the man, the woman should do nothing to suggest the changing of the divine order. In the worship assemblies each person is to express reverence for God, in acceptance of the role which they have been given.

Apparently, the Corinthians had addressed a question to Paul regarding the role of men and women in the worship assembly. Paul began by reminding them of the Divine order. He gave answer, "But I want you to know that the head of every man is Christ, the head of woman is man, and the head of Christ is God" (1 Cor. 11:3). He reminded them that there is a subordination of persons to be honored in the church; that as Christ, as Mediator, is subject to God the Father, but is the head and lord of all men, being his Creator and Redeemer; so the man is the head of the woman, and she must show subjection unto the man. As Christ acts in subordination to the Father, so must the woman act in subordination to the man.

Clearly, man has responsibilities of leadership and of submission. Furthermore, he is to conduct himself in a way that gives evidence of reverence for the will of God. Paul wrote in specific terms, "Every man praying or prophesying, having his head covered, dishonors his head." (I Cor. 11:4).

The statement, "Every man praying and prophesying," is to be understood of his engaging in acts of divine worship. "Having his head covered," is the act of using an artificial covering, a cloth, a hat, or a veil. This was literally after the manner of women; a token of subjection. Paul stated that the man that does this, "dishonors his head," Christ.


To enter into worship is to be ruled by the will of God, not by human tradition. Christ, the head of the church is to be the focus of divine service. When man covers his head in worship, he dishonors Christ. He undeniably shows contempt for Christ!

God requires that all come to Him with respectful conduct; and in respectful dress. In conduct and in dress, in every gesture, each person is to avoid that which is not right and respectful. Each person is to conduct himself as becomes a servant of God. It is abundantly clear, that which Paul decreed regarding the covering of the head was a commandment of God; not a holy hint, nor basis for a tradition.

Paul gave this clear directive: "For a man indeed ought not to cover his head, since he is the image and glory of God; but woman is the glory of man" (I Cor. 11:7).

The distinction of the sexes was established by the Lord God. That He desires that the roles of men and women be evident in the church, especially in the assembly, is established in these words written by Paul. The roles of men and women are to be kept distinct, even in the wearing of a head covering. It is not simply a matter of hats! The will of God is to be honored!

## A Father's Example

A small boy was consistently late coming home from school. His parents warned him one day that he must be home on time that afternoon, but nevertheless he arrived later than ever. His mother met him at the door and said nothing.

At dinner that night, the boy looked at his plate. There was a slice of bread and a glass of water. He looked at his father's full plate and then at his father, but his father remained silent. The boy was crushed.

The father waited for the full impact to sink in, then quietly took the boy's plate and placed it in front of himself. He took his own plate of meat and potatoes, put it in front of the boy, and smiled at his son.

When that boy grew to be a man, he said, "All my life I've known what God is like by what my father did that night."

We ALL sin and fall short of the glory of God (Romans 3:23), we ALL deserve the wages of sin: DEATH (Romans 6:23). THIS is what God is like: He is a JUST God (Psalm 89:14), and He is also a LOVING God (1 John 4:7-8). As He is a JUST God, He must punish sin. As He is a LOVING God, He provided a way for us to have forgiveness, that way was through the gift of His Son, Jesus, to die on the cross for the sins of the world (1 John 2:2).

A wonderful exchange is made possible through Jesus Christ: He took the punishment for our sins and He offers us His righteousness. "For He [God] made Him who knew no sin [Jesus] to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him" (2 Corinthians 5:21). The "exchange" is activated when we: believe in Jesus (Acts 16:30-31), repent of our sins (Acts 17:30-31), confess Jesus before men (Romans 10:9-10), and are baptized (immersed) into Christ for the forgiveness of our sins (Acts 2:38). Then, as we continue to walk in the light of God's Word, the blood of Jesus will continue to cleanse us from all unrighteousness (1 John 1:7-9).

In the exchange of dinner plates, that small boy learned the meaning of GRACE from his father. Grace is something we NEED but we do not DESERVE. The boy's example illustrates what the Heavenly Father offers to YOU and ME. We deserve DEATH, but He offers us forgiveness and LIFE! That's something we need but we don't deserve; that's GRACE!

Won't YOU accept His grace through your faithful obedience today?
