

Sermon Summaries

Morning *The Gospel According to Jesus: God Desires True Worship – John 4:1-26*

When reading about the life of Jesus and what He teaches, it is not hard to conclude that Jesus calls us to a lifestyle standard that is challenging. He set the bar high and He wants us to live up to that standard. In John 4, a person asks Jesus about the proper place of worship. She wants to know if the proper place is Mt. Gerizim or Jerusalem. In a way, her question reveals a low bar in understanding worship. The true worship is not a matter of location, but a matter of the human heart. True worship occurs when we worship in spirit and in truth.

Evening *The Reign of God: The Problem With Kings – Deuteronomy 17:14-20*

The problem with kings is that they think they are kings. They believe that they hold ultimate authority and they since they occupy that position, they have the right to do what they want. There is a long history of kings thinking that because they have royal blood, they are chosen by God to rule over the people. In the Davidic line of Israel, they were chosen to by God, to rule on His behalf. Things broke down when they ignored God's commands and usurped God's rule. Things will always go bad when we do this.
