A few months ago, I did a set of lessons that shared information concerning the importance of rediscovering the mission of the New Testament Church. Many congregations of the Church of Christ are experiencing a decline in membership numbers because they are not following the Final Command of Jesus to “Go, and make disciples...” This was not intended to be a criticism of the Mt. Vernon congregation. It is an encouragement to identify where we could do a better job in teaching the Good News about Jesus to our community. We live in critical times and we need all the tools that are available to reach those who are lost.

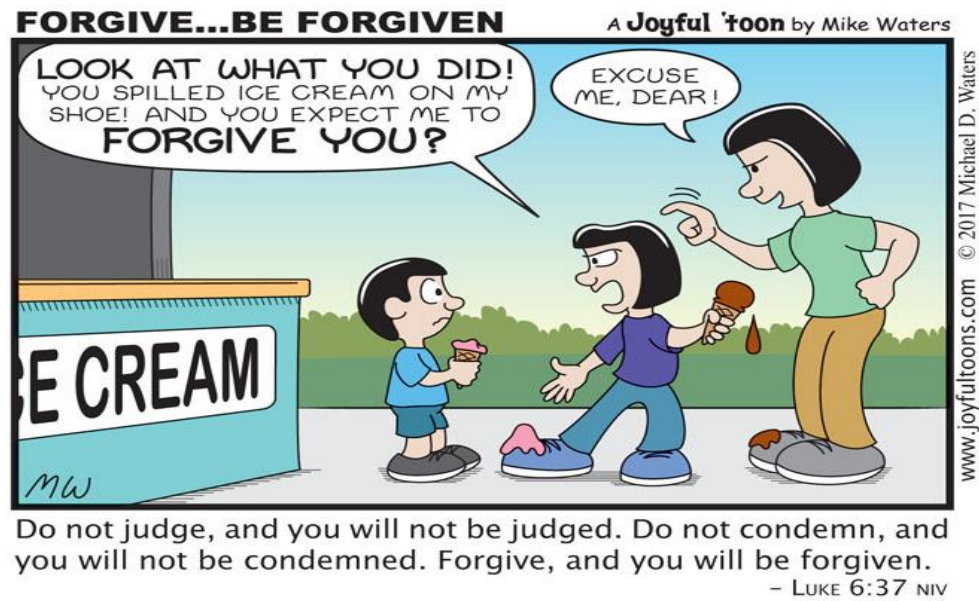
